

**CENTRAL DUPAGE CAMERA CLUB
CONSTITUTION**

ARTICLE 1. Name and Objective:

- Section 1. Name: Central DuPage Camera Club, hereinafter referred to as the CLUB.
- Section 2. Objective: Development of fellowship among members and promotion of Interest and activity in photography in DuPage County and surrounding Areas.

ARTICLE 2. Membership:

- Section 1. Eligibility: Any individual interested in any phase of photography.
- Section 2. Enrolling: An individual becomes a member by paying his or her dues to the Treasurer of the CLUB.

ARTICLE 3. Officers and Board of Directors:

- Section 1. Officers: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and Chicago Area Camera Club Association (CACCA) Delegate. One of the other officers may also serve as the CACCA Delegate.
- Section 2. Board of Directors: Shall consist of the officers listed in Section 1 of this Article, the immediate Past President and other members in good standing of the CLUB as required to comprise a board of seven persons.
- Section 3. Term of Office: The term of office for each officer and Board member shall be one year. No member shall fill the same office for more than two successive terms except as Secretary and CACCA Delegate. The term of office commences upon installation at the Annual Awards Banquet.
- Section 4. Order of Succession: If the President of the CLUB is unable to perform his or her duties of the office, the duties shall be performed by one of the other officers in the following order of succession:
 - 1. Vice President
 - 2. Immediate Past President
 - 3. Treasurer
 - 4. Secretary
- Section 5. Attendance: Any Board member who is absent from four consecutive Board meetings may be replaced by action of the Board, if such action is in the best interests of the CLUB.

ARTICLE 4. Selection of Officers and Board Members:

- Section 1. Nominating Committee: Shall submit recommendations for officers and Board members to the CLUB members one month before the election.
- Section 2. Election: Shall be held at the May business meeting.

ARTICLE 5. Board Meetings:

The Board of Directors shall meet at such time and place as specified by either the President or any three Board members. A Board meeting shall not be called more than once a month unless agreed to by three or more Board members.

ARTICLE 6. Dissolution of the CLUB:

In the event that the CLUB should be dissolved, title to all property owned by the CLUB at that time shall vest in the then acting Board of Directors who shall convert all assets into cash and make equal distribution of such final cash to each of the members in good standing during the year in which dissolution takes place.

ARTICLE 7. Amendments:

Amendments to this constitution shall be submitted in writing to the Board of Directors. Those amendments approved by the Board shall then be read at the next CLUB business meeting at that meeting or the next consecutive business meeting . Two thirds of the members in good standing must be present at the time of voting and approval by a majority shall be necessary for adoption.
